Official Mascot Announced for the 5th Asian Para Games Aichi-Nagoya 2026!

> The Official Mascot for the 5th Asian Para Games Aichi-Nagoya 2026 was officially announced on Tuesday, September 17, 2024.

This mascot is a combination of two concepts: "water," which supports Aichi prefecture, a leading manufacturing region in Japan, and "shachihoko," a guardian god of Nagoya City. The attractive features of this mascot, "Uzumin," are large, cute eyes and a head that resembles the tail of shachihoko. Through its eyes, Uzumin is always watching over the performances of para-athletes across Asia. Having the mysterious power of the guardian god in its head, Uzumin can deliver cheers from children all over Asia to the para-athletes.

The official mascot, "Uzumin," made its debut at an event.

On Saturday, October 12, 2024, the official mascot made its debut at the two-year countdown ceremony to Aichi-Nagoya 2026 held at AEON Mall Atsuta, where it was introduced as "Uzumin." The name "Uzumin" consists of two words: "Uzu"

(whirlpool) and "Izumi" (spring). By extending the concept of "water," we selected these two words. This name represents our hope that the passion of para-athletes will be gathered at Aichi-Nagoya 2026 like a "whirlpool," and people's heartfelt emotions born there will rise up like a "spring" and spread all over Asia.

Call for Volunteers for Aichi-Nagoya 2026!



The volunteer application period for Aichi-Nagoya 2026 has been extended!

The deadline of the volunteer application period for Aichi-Nagoya 2026 had formerly been Friday, January 31, 2025; however, we were requested to extend the application period to take into account students who will be enrolling at university or technical school, those who will graduate, and those who will start working from April. We have extended the application period to Wednesday, April 30, 2025.
